Job Description

COFI is seeking an **Analyst** to join our team based in our Vancouver office. They will work closely with members of COFI's policy team and collaborate with member companies and government. The successful candidate should have the capacity to undertake research, interpret data and identify the impacts of policy change on industry economics. This position reports directly to the Vice President & Chief Economist. Periodic travel within Canada may be required.

The Analyst's responsibilities will include:

- Generate policy ideas and participate in policy discussions.
- Conduct research and analysis to aid in the preparation of policy positions and documents.
- Manage databases associated with the forest sector, including trade, employment and other economic activity statistics.
- Help generate monthly and quarterly reports.
- Use statistical techniques to assess past and future trends related to forest industry activity.
- Assess impacts of proposed policy, legislative or regulatory changes on the financial health of the industry.

Qualifications and Competencies

- Undergraduate degree in Forestry (with good quantitative skills), commerce or economics. Master's degree is an asset.
- Experience in the Canadian resource sector (forestry, mining, oil and gas, energy) would be considered an advantage.
- Advanced knowledge of Excel. Experience with analytical software such as Power BI, Tableau, Stata and R would be an asset.
- Good written and oral communication skills.
- Outstanding work ethic, strong initiative and ability to work unsupervised and independently.
